


## What does the service offer?

- Consultant led preconceptual counselling
- All types of pregnancy ultrasound scanning
- Recurrent miscarriage investigations and advice
- Nuchal Translucency scan & bloods (11-13 weeks + 6 days)
- Viability scans (after 5 weeks)
- Sexing scans (after 16 weeks)
- Dating scans (8-16 weeks)
- Dating scans & combined screening (Nuchal Translucency scan & bloods)
- Reassurance scans (14-22 weeks)
- Harmony Prenatal Testing
- Sickle cell, thalassemia and cystic fibrosis screening
- Screening for pre-eclampsia (combined screening and UT artery) (13-22 weeks)
- Screening for pre-term birth (after 16 weeks)
- Anatomy scans (18-21 weeks)
- 3D/4D scans (24-34 weeks)
- Fetal wellbeing scans (24-40 weeks)
- Private deliveries can be arranged with Professor Anumba and Mr Jokhi at the Jessop Wing, Royal Hallamshire Hospital (not available at Claremont Private Hospital)



### HOW TO FIND US

Claremont Private Hospital is situated 3 miles (about 20 minutes) to the south west of Sheffield City Centre.

#### Public Transport

The hospital is served by the number 51 bus which leaves from the city centre to Lodge Moor. You can get on at the Crucible Theatre/Arundel Gate and be dropped off at the hospital entrance.

#### By Car

Leave the M1 at Junction 33 and follow signs for Sheffield. Before Park Square roundabout, turn right taking the A61 ring road down Derek Dooley Way (following the signs for Hospital and University). At the next roundabout, follow the A57 signposted Glossop. At the next roundabout, take the third exit signposted Glossop. You will pass the University on the right and Sheffield Children's Hospital and Weston Park Hospital on the left, before reaching Broomhill. Continue past the shops and at the second set of traffic lights, turn right, signposted Manchester and Glossop. Continue for approximately 1 mile and turn left on Selborne Road, just before the petrol station. Turn left onto Sandygate Road and we are about 1 mile further up on the left.

### **Professor Dilly Anumba MBBS, FWACS, MD, FRCOG, LLM Medical Law** CONSULTANT OBSTETRICIAN & GYNAECOLOGIST

Professor Dilly Anumba is Professor of Obstetrics and Gynaecology at the University of Sheffield Medical School, and Consultant Obstetrician & Gynaecologist within Sheffield Teaching Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust. He also holds additional specialist qualifications in Maternal and Fetal Medicine.

Professor Anumba runs pregnancy care clinics and services including specialised clinics in Prenatal Diagnosis and Fetal Therapy, Prematurity Prevention, and Maternal Medicine. He has particular expertise in ultrasonography and is the pioneer and Course Director of the highly popular Sheffield Fetal Biometry Courses that attract national and international doctor delegates from Ireland, the Middle East and Africa.

He has published over 100 peer-reviewed journal papers and abstracts in top medical journals, and book chapters on topics relating to pregnancy care and women's health issues. Some of his work has explored the factors that influence the bond between a mother and her yet-to-be-born child. Professor Anumba is highly research active and leads many funded research projects investigating several aspects of human pregnancy, including novel techniques to predict and thus mitigate premature birth.

He serves on several professional and research bodies in Women's Health and is reviewer to major national and international Reproductive Health Journals, Research Boards and Charities.



### **Mr Roobin Jokhi BMedSci (Hons), MBChB, MRCOG** SPECIALIST IN OBSTETRICS & GYNAECOLOGY

Mr Roobin Jokhi graduated from the University of Sheffield and trained in Obstetrics and Gynaecology in Nottingham and Sheffield.

He has a 1st Class Honours degree for his research into Reproductive Biology and has more recently conducted postgraduate research into innovative ways of predicting the factors influencing labour and delivery. He has also published work on the possible causes of pre-term labour as well as the factors influencing timing and prediction of induced labour, working closely in conjunction with Professor Anumba.

Mr Jokhi is an RCOG (Royal College of Gynaecologists) accredited specialist in Maternal and Fetal Medicine and runs specialist clinics in prenatal diagnosis, with extensive experience of both normal and high risk pregnancies. He is also accredited by the Fetal Medicine Foundation to perform Nuchal Translucency scans.

Mr Jokhi has a keen interest in women with more complex medical disorders, particularly kidney disease but also runs clinics for women with other medical problems including endocrine and connective tissue disease.
